On September 20, 2019 Fetterolf Corporation (a SchuF company) celebrated 50 years as a designer and manufacturer of high quality industrial valves for the chemical, petrochemical, mining, oil and gas industries.





One of the first valves was developed for and with the Dow Corporation – a bottom outlet valve with exceptional sealing to process (measured at  $1 \times 10^{-8}$  CC per second) was the Ram-Seal valve. Almost 50 years later the **Ram-Seal** is still the best performing soft seal tank/drain valve available on the market today. Its clog free performance, effective zero leakage to process and variants that deliver 5-6 years mean time between maintenance (MTBM) make it the valve of choice for Polyethylene (PE) and High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) and general Polymer service.



A few years later Fetterolf launched a Seatless valve – the **Rod-Seal**. Its Seatless design and Superclosure feature make it ideal for applications with highly viscous media, powders and fluids that harden quickly and render most valves and in particular ball valves ineffective. It has become and still is the valve of choice to drain reactors and vessels for the PVC and mining industry. The Superclosure feature ensures tight shut off as well and wear compensation for packing.

Since the early days, Fetterolf has launched the **Straightway** Valve (an efficient high Cv Y-Globe valve), many polymer diverter valve designs, sampling valves, a fixed nozzle desuperheater, and a complete range of fast acting line blind valves such as the **Cam-Set**, **Cam-Slide** and **Stacey**. The Cam-Set was the first quick-acting line blind valve to be launched worldwide.

Fetterolf continues to innovate and add new products to its portfolio, with the launch of a **Non-spill Cam-Slide** in 2014 and **Rupture Disc Changing Line Blind** in 2017. Group SchuF CEO Dr. Martin Frank commented:

"When we acquired Fetterolf in 2004, we knew that we were acquiring some excellent brands, but the company continues to surprise us with new products and innovations to existing products."
